

Cookies Policy

Pursuant to European Regulation 2016/679 (hereafter also the "Regulation") and national law, Arexpo S.p.A. (hereafter "Arexpo" or the "Data Controller"), in its capacity as Data Controller, hereby sets out its complete policy regarding the cookies installed on Arexpo's institutional site (hereafter also the "Site"), for purposes of explaining the types of cookies and how they are used, and to provide information on actions to refuse or delete cookies.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are short text files that web applications send to visitors for various purposes.

They may be classified using various criteria:

The site that generates them: proprietary cookies, installed directly by the manager of the site the user is visiting, and third party cookies, which are installed by another website other than the one the user is visiting.

Purpose: Technical cookies are intended to manage the technical aspects necessary to provide a service requested by the user, such as to browse a website, manage a user's session, or automatically recognize the preferred language.

Analytical cookies are used to collect information on the number of users and how they visit the website, and then to process general statistics on the service and its use. Profiling cookies are used to analyze the user's browsing preferences and create profiles based on how they interact with the site.

Duration: permanent cookies are stored on the device permanently, temporary cookies have a variable and limited duration, and session cookies disappear when the browser is closed or when the user logs out.

2. What cookies are used on this Site and for what purposes?

2.1 Technical cookies (do not require the data subject's consent)

This Site uses technical cookies that are necessary for proper functioning of the Site, to permit efficient browsing of the Site, and to guarantee that visitors can browse safely. These cookies are strictly necessary for the above purposes and to enable users to use the content and services they request.

Following is a list with the description/use and duration of the cookies used and links to the privacy policy of any third party involved:

4. Information on user management of cookies

4.1 Disable cookies

It's possible to disable all cookies stored on your hard drive by going to the special section of the browser. Therefore, we suggest consulting the specific instructions on the browser used.

4.2 Activate anonymous browsing

This function, which is now available on all browsers, can be used to browse the internet without saving any information on the sites and pages visited.



Nevertheless, note that even when this function is activated, browsing data are registered and stored by website managers and connectivity providers.

4.3 Directly delete cookies

At present almost all browsers make it possible to delete installed cookies.

For more detailed instructions, consult your browser guidelines.

Nevertheless, the cookies will be reinstalled during each new session; for this reason, you should perform this operation periodically or use automated functions for periodic deletion.

7. Knowledge and dissemination of data

Data collected using cookies will be processed exclusively by the Data Controller, the appointed data processors and any other specially appointed suppliers, and by personnel with special training in data processing and protection in order to ensure the same level of security offered by the data controller.

Personal data may not be disseminated in any way.

8. Transfer of personal data to non-EU countries

The personal data collected are transferred outside the European Union in the manners permitted by the Regulation, in accordance with Articles 44 et seq.

9. Rights of the Data Subject

Data Subjects may exercise their rights under Articles 15-22 of EU Regulation 679/2016, when applicable, such as the right to access personal data, rectify them, erase them, limit their processing, and oppose them, as well as the right of data portability.

Data Subjects also have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority under Art. 77 of the Regulation.
